Introduction



The Signs of Astrology

Right now, as you're reading these words, a baby is being born somewhere in the world. According to astrology, the precise position of the sun, the moon, the planets, and other astronomical bodies at this very moment can tell us about the kind of person that baby will become, their likes and dislikes, even what they might do for a living. It may seem like fortune-telling, but the magic of astrology is less about predicting the future than it is about having the power to see yourself clearly—and learn more about who you are.

Different cultures have different astrological systems, but each system shares the belief that we can glean remarkable knowledge about people from the locations of celestial objects at the time of their birth.

The zodiac of Western astrology has twelve signs. Although many factors have gone into making you the special person that you are, in astrology, the most important consideration is known as the zodiac sign, or sun sign. When someone asks, "What's your sign?" that's what they're talking about.

Each sign is named for a constellation through which the sun appears to move during a certain period of time during the year. Each has a corresponding element—fire, earth, air, or water—along with lucky days, preferred scents, special gems, symbolic animals, and much more. Signs with the same elements tend to have some similarities as well as the potential to be close friends.

Astrology Through the Ages

People have long relied on the night sky to navigate their lives. Our Stone Age ancestors notched the phases of the moon into bone some thirty-four thousand years ago, while sailors in the northern hemisphere have steered by the North Star for millennia.

Across eras and cultures, individuals began seeing patterns and shapes twinkling in the heavens above—what we call constellations—and they started telling stories about what they saw.

These interpretations took on predictive powers. By 1500 BCE, Babylonian priests in Mesopotamia had divided the sky into twelve parts. Each part of the zodiac was given a name, assigned certain symbols and colors, and ascribed different characteristics. Gods were connected to the sun, moon, and planets. After Alexander the Great conquered the area in 331 BCE, the Greeks took over the Babylonian astrological system, incorporating elements from Egypt.

For hundreds of years, astrology was inextricably bound to religion and politics. Roman rulers studied the horoscopes of their enemies and relied on astrologers to pinpoint auspicious dates for attacks. During the Renaissance, some Catholic popes consulted in-house astrologers, as did Queen Elizabeth. Shakespeare referenced astrology in his plays.

Astrology fell out of favor during the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, known as the Age of Enlightenment. But, of course, astrology never died out. Instead, it broadened to

encompass new planets, such as Uranus and Neptune, as they were discovered in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. By the 1960s, astrology had once again entered the mainstream, thanks to a generation of curious individuals looking to find answers about their place in the world.

Today, astrology is one of many tools we have to help us not only figure out but also appreciate what it means to be ourselves.

How the Planets Fit In

As with the sun in our solar system, our sun sign represents our core or very essence. It's the most powerful indicator of our personalities. Nevertheless, we're also affected by the planets and their relationship to one another.











The planets represent motivations, influences, and approaches. (In astrology, note that "planet" means "celestial body"—sometimes it's a moon, star, or minor planet.) As they move through the zodiac, they impact our lives.

Each sign is said to be ruled by at least one planet. Put another way: although every planet affects every sign, each planet has a

special relationship with at least one sign. During that sign’s time period, the planet will be at its strongest and most influential.

How the Houses Fit In

Along with the twelve signs of the zodiac, astrology has twelve houses, which oversee various parts of a person’s life, such as money or friendship. Each house is ruled by a sign, and the house and its ruling sign share characteristics.

Your birth chart offers a map of everything at the moment of your birth, including the presence or absence of planets in the various houses. To get a birth chart, you'll need to know the exact time and location of your birth, although astrologers can make adjustments if you don't know specific details. (Plenty of sites online offer free birth charts, such as shop.astrology.com/birth-chart/.)

Having a planet in a particular house when you were born can bring out different facets of your sun sign, or determine areas of interest or importance to you. A house without a planet in it is still a part of your life, but it just might not be as relevant as a house with a planet. Some houses might have multiple planets in them. The more planets in a house, the more noteworthy that house.

In addition to the position of the planets, your birth chart will indicate your rising sign, or the sign that was on the cusp of the first house at the time of your birth. It's called the rising sign, or ascendant, because it was rising, or ascending, on the eastern horizon when you were born. Knowing your rising sign can give you clues about your character, especially if you've never felt totally in sync with your sun sign. Since it's affiliated with the first house, your rising sign is associated with your personality and how people perceive you.

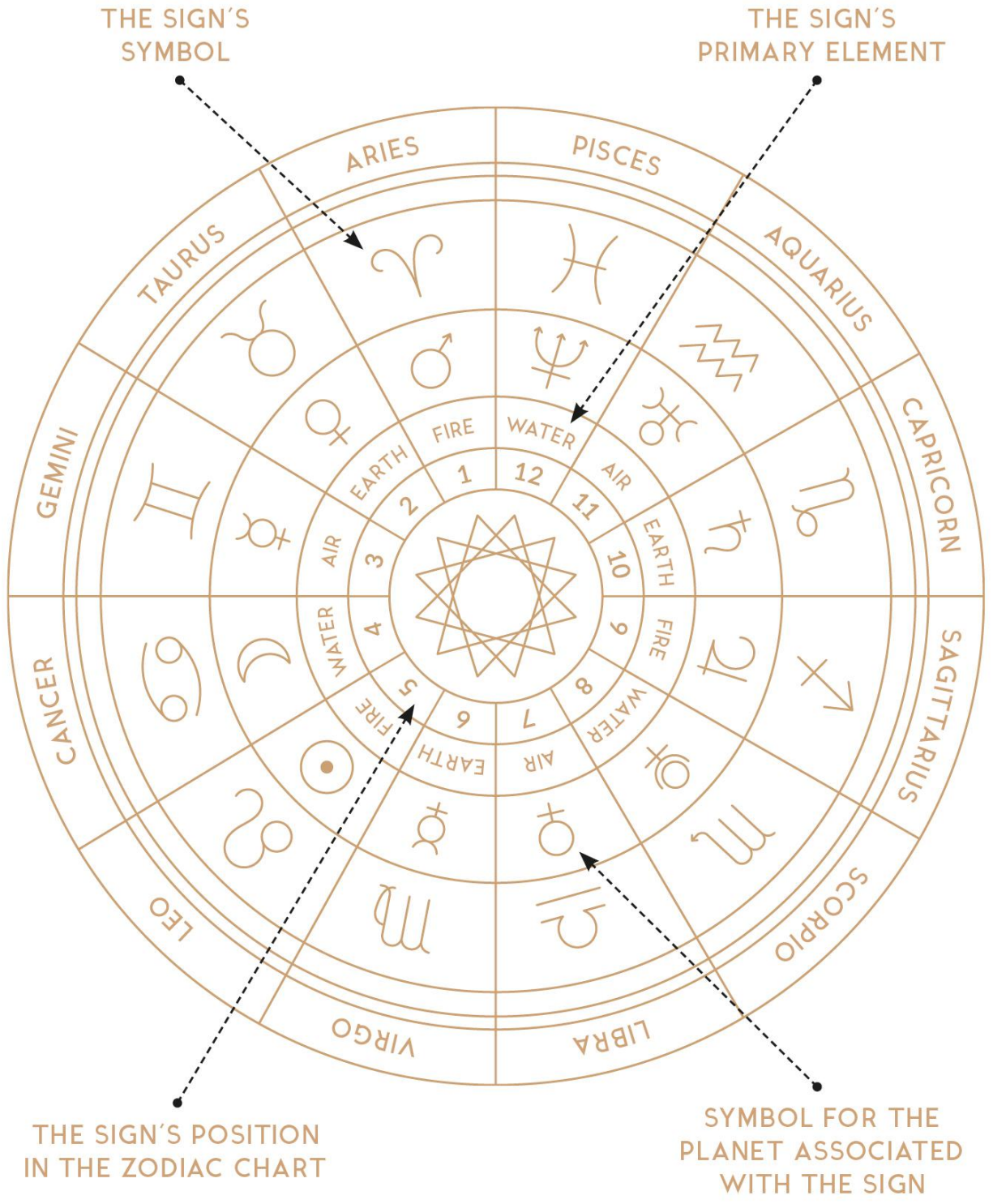

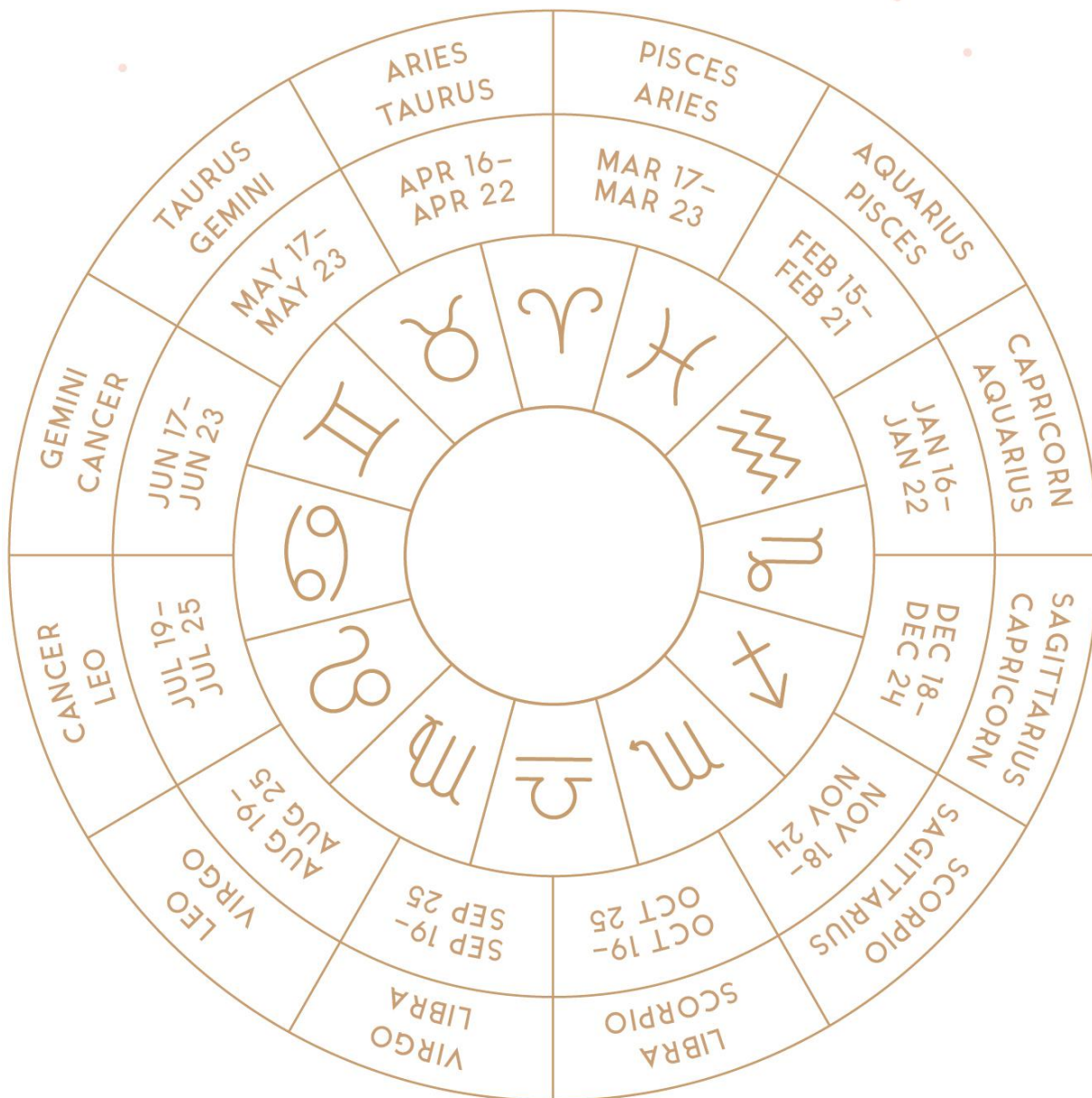

Ways Aries Can Stretch Themselves

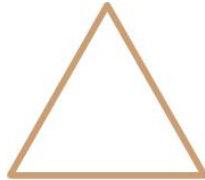
